Seniors wishing to be in the Debutante Court must first get her parent's permission. She then must raise a minimum of \$1000. Contestants may raise money by sales on and off the campus. No gum may be sold on campus. If someone is sponsoring a raffle, she must inform the office. The drawing for such a raffle must be done in a public place.

In order to sell sandwiches, nachos, chicken or such items, the contestant should ask for a sale date from the office. Items such as: candy, chips, pickles, etc. may be sold daily.

If a student wishes to sell items on campus she must first make a \$300.00 nonrefundable deposit. If she later drops out of the competition, she must turn in all monies raised.

The Debutante Court Contest ends **Thursday, February 1, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.** All monies must be handed in at that time. Doors are locked at 5:00 p.m. Anyone who arrives after that time will be placed last in the contest. No personal checks are accepted. All monies must be in large bills. Money orders and cashier checks may be used.
